


Weddings at The Swan



A regular winner of the Best Kept Village award, Tarporley appears in the Domesday Book of 1086. Back then, Tarporley was home to just eight households, but today is one of the largest villages in the heart of the Cheshire countryside, with a beautiful church, antiques, curio and fashion shops lining its streets. Perfect for photo opportunities. The Swan sits in the heart of the village, walking distance from the church and is itself a stunning backdrop.









The 16th century Swan has been welcoming guests through its doors for over 400 years and was once a convenient resting place for those travelling the 200 miles from London to Chester. Today, our comfortable rooms and welcoming bar and dining areas mean that The Swan continues to be a haven for visitors from far and wide.


The bar boasts 3 fine cask ales (supporting local breweries such as the award-winning Weetwood Ales) craft lagers, cider and an array of bottled drinks from around the world. A short but well considered wine list (selected by leading wine expert, Jon from Define Wine) will compliment any of our seasonal dishes. An artisan gin list and a fine selection of malt whisky's complete the lineup.





The Swan's most historic feature, The Tarporley Room is a perfect venue for weddings due to its unique character complimented by an antique chandelier and beautiful paintings. The scene is finished with a stunning open fire, ideal for winter weddings. The room comfortably seats 80 guests. Adjacent to the Tarporley Room is a private bar so you are offered complete privacy in a unique atmosphere.

The room is one of the most stunning and historic event rooms in the North of England with history dating back to 1762.



For Weddings where you have both your ceremony and reception with us, our recently refurbished Pickering Room can be made available for your drinks reception whilst we turn The Tarporley Room into your perfect Wedding Breakfast. We also have seating outside, perfect for those summer days.
